Survey conducted April 19 through April 20, 2022. 801 likely 2022 Primary voters participated in the survey. Survey weighted to match expected turnout demographics for the 2022 Primary Election. Margin of Error is +/-3.3% with a 95% level of confidence. Totals do not always equal 100% due to rounding.
