



NORTH DAKOTA TERM LIMITS POLL: EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

US Term Limits survey conducted Nov. 30 through Dec. 5, 2022

by RMG Research Group.

500 Registered Voters in ND participated in the survey.

A large majority (81%) of North Dakotan voters favor an amendment imposing term limits on Congress. 83% of voters also say that they would like an age limit for members of Congress so that no one over 85 years old could serve or be elected. Additionally, 95% of voters believe it should be required that all members of Congress must reside in their districts for at least one year prior to the election.

Methodology

The survey of 500 Registered Voters was conducted for USTL on Nov. 30 - Dec. 5, 2022. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by gender, age, and race. Likely voters were determined by a screening process within the survey.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 4.5 percentage points.
