*1\* Do you approve or disapprove of the way President Biden is performing his job?*

57% Strongly approve  
25% Somewhat approve  
6% Somewhat disapprove  
10% Strongly disapprove  
2% Not sure

*2\* Okay... In your district Sheila Cherfilus-McCormick and Dale Holness are running in the Democratic Congressional Primary. If the election were held today, for whom would you vote?*

45% Sheila Cherfilus-McCormick  
21% Dale Holness  
34% Some other candidate/Not sure

*3\* Do you favor or oppose term limits for members of Congress?*

59% Strongly favor  
16% Somewhat favor  
7% Somewhat oppose  
3% Strongly oppose  
14% Not sure

*4\* [Asked of those who favor Term Limits] Would you prefer limits of three terms (six years) or six terms (twelve years)?*

74% Three terms (six years)  
20% Six terms (twelve years)  
6% Not sure

*5\* Suppose you knew that Sheila Cherfilus-McCormick signed the pledge to support congressional term limits, but has not kept her pledge since being elected, for whom would you vote?*

30% Sheila Cherfilus-McCormick  
31% Dale Holness  
39% Some other candidate/Not sure

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**Methodology**

The survey of 500 Likely Voters was conducted for USTL on June 4-6, 2022. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by gender, age, and race. Likely voters were determined by a screening process within the survey.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 4.5 percentage points.
