1* Do you approve or disapprove of the way President Biden is performing his job?

25% Strongly approve15% Somewhat approve8% Somewhat disapprove48% Strongly disapprove

2* Okay... In your district, Republican Sandy Smith and Democrat Donald Davis are running in the midterm election for Congress. If the election were held today, for whom would you vote?

39% Republican Sandy Smith
45% Democrat Donald Davis
16% Would not vote/Not sure

3* Do you favor or oppose term limits for members of Congress?

61% Strongly favor15% Somewhat favor4% Somewhat oppose4% Strongly oppose17% Not sure

4* [Asked of those who favor Term Limits] Would you prefer limits of three terms (six years) or six terms (twelve years)?

77% Three terms (six years)
15% Six terms (twelve years)
8% Not sure

5* Suppose you knew that Republican Sandy Smith signed the U.S. Term Limits pledge and supports term limits, but Democrat Donald Davis opposes term limits. If you knew that to be true and the election were held today, for whom would you vote?

43% Republican Sandy Smith38% Democrat Donald Davis20% Would not vote/Not sure



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Methodology

The survey of 500 Likely Voters was conducted for USTL on June 4-6, 2022. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by gender, age, and race. Likely voters were determined by a screening process within the survey.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 4.5 percentage points.
