- 1. Do you approve or disapprove of the way President Biden is performing his job?
 - 21% Strongly approve
 - 22% Somewhat approve
 - 9% Somewhat disapprove
 - 46% Strongly disapprove
 - 1% Not sure
- 2* Okay... In your district Republican Bob Healey and Democrat Andrew Kim are running in the midterm election for Congress. If the election were held today, for whom would you vote?
 - 38% Republican Bob Healey
 - 44% Democrat Andrew Kim
 - 4% Some other candidate
 - 13% Not sure
 - 3* Do you favor or oppose term limits for members of Congress?
 - 61% Strongly favor
 - 23% Somewhat favor
 - 6% Somewhat oppose
 - 3% Strongly oppose
 - 8% Not sure
- 4* [Asked of those who favor term limits] Would you prefer limits of three terms (six years) or six terms (twelve years)?
 - 76% Three terms (6 years)
 - 17% Six terms (12 years)
 - 7% Not sure

Methodology

The survey of 400 Likely Midterm Voters was conducted for USTL on July 22-29. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by gender, age, and race. Likely voters were determined by a screening process within the survey.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 4.9 percentage points.
