

## **US Term Limits Survey**

of 400 Likely Midterm Voters in NY19 Conducted August 27-September 2, 2022

- 1. Do you approve or disapprove of the way President Biden is performing his job?
  - 25% Strongly approve
  - 21% Somewhat approve
  - 6% Somewhat disapprove
  - 48% Strongly disapprove
  - 0% Not sure
- 2\* Okay... In your district Republican Marc Molinaro and Democrat Josh Riley are running in the midterm election for Congress. If the election were held today, for whom would you vote?
  - 41% Republican Marc Molinaro
  - 44% Democrat Josh Riley
  - 1% Some other candidate
  - 13% Not sure
  - 3\* Do you favor or oppose term limits for members of Congress?
    - 61% Strongly favor
    - 24% Somewhat favor
    - 6% Somewhat oppose
    - 3% Strongly oppose
    - 6% Not sure
- 4\* [Asked of those who favor term limits] Would you prefer limits of three terms (six years) or six terms (twelve years)?
  - 74% Three terms (6 years)
  - 19% Six terms (12 years)
  - 6% Not sure





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5\* If you knew that Republican Marc Molinaro signed the U.S. Term Limits Pledge and supports term limits, but Democrat Josh Riley opposes term limits, for whom would you vote?

48% Republican Marc Molinaro

36% Democrat Josh Riley

3% Some other candidate

13% Not sure

## Methodology

The survey of 400 Likely Midterm Voters was conducted for USTL on August 27-September 2. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by gender, age, and race. Likely voters were determined by a screening process within the survey.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 4.9 percentage points.
