1* Do you approve or disapprove of the way President Biden is performing his job?

26% Strongly approve
16% Somewhat approve
6% Somewhat disapprove
50% Strongly disapprove
1% Not sure

2* Okay... In your district Republican Alek Skarlatos and Democrat Val Hoyle are running in the midterm elections for Congress. If the election were held today, for whom would you vote?

45% Republican Alek Skarlatos46% Democrat Val Hoyle

9% Would not vote/Not sure

3* Do you favor or oppose term limits for members of Congress?

69% Strongly favor
18% Somewhat favor
5% Somewhat oppose
4% Strongly oppose
5% Not sure

4* [Asked of those who favor Term Limits] Would you prefer limits of three terms (six years) or six terms (twelve years)?

71% Three terms (six years)
23% Six terms (twelve years)
7% Not sure

5* Suppose you knew that Republican Alek Skarlatos signed the U.S. Term Limits pledge and supports term limits, but Democrat Val Hoyle opposes term limits. If you knew that to be true and the election were held today, for whom would you vote?

49% Republican Alek Skarlatos
40% Democrat Val Hoyle
12% Would not vote/Not sure



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Methodology

The survey of 500 Likely Voters was conducted for USTL on June 4-6, 2022. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by gender, age, and race. Likely voters were determined by a screening process within the survey.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 4.5 percentage points.
