



US TERM LIMITS POLL: GOVERNOR DESANTIS APPROVAL
 Florida Survey of 800 Likely Voters Conducted February 15-17, 2019
 by Pulse Opinion Research (Rasmussen Field Team)

Survey Summary: The results of this recently completed statewide survey show that Florida voters approve of Governor Ron DeSantis by a margin of 64%-24%. DeSantis' high marks, along with a net approval of 30 points, would place him among the most popular governors in America per Morning Consult quarterly governor ratings.

Support for DeSantis is broad across nearly all political and demographic groups. He has net positive approval among Republicans, Democrats and Independents; additionally, DeSantis' net approval is even higher with Hispanic voters (62%-20%) than among the general public.

Methodology: This poll of 800 likely voters in Florida was conducted February 15-17, 2019, using an automated polling methodology. To reach those who have abandoned traditional landline telephones, Pulse Opinion Research uses an online survey tool to interview randomly selected participants from a demographically diverse panel. This accounts for 25% of the panel. Pulse Opinion Research determines its partisan weighting targets through a dynamic weighting system that takes into account the state's voting history, national trends, and recent polling in a particular state or geographic area.

This poll of 800 likely voters in Florida has an accuracy of +/- 3.5% with a 95% level of confidence.
