**Re: Initial Cure of Term Limits Petitions**

Dear Secretary Jaeger:

We write on behalf of our client<sup>1</sup>, North Dakota for Term Limits (the “Committee”), regarding the correction and amendment of certain issues raised by your office on the initiative petitions submitted by the Committee (the “Petitions”). The proposed initiative would add a new article to the North Dakota Constitution imposing term limits for the Governor and members of the Legislature.

For an initiative petition to be placed on a ballot, it must be signed by electors equal in number to four percent of the North Dakota population. N.D. Const. Art. III, sect. 9. In 2022, 31,164 signatures are necessary for an initiative petition to be placed on the ballot. See Ex. A, Timeline. On February 15, 2022, your office accepted delivery of 1,441 Petitions from the Committee containing 46,366 signatures in support of the term limits initiative. See Ex. B, 3/22/22 Letter from Jaeger to Hendrix. The Petitions included approximately 15,000 more signatures than the law requires to have the issue placed on the ballot.

North Dakota law states that the “Secretary of State shall have a reasonable period, not to exceed thirty-five days, in which to pass upon the sufficiency of any petition mentioned in section 16.1-01-09.” N.D.C.C. 16.1-01-10.

On March 22, 2022, you notified the Committee that it did not submit enough signatures to place the Term Limits issue on the ballot because, based on your review, only 17,265 of the 46,366 signatures submitted were valid. In your opinion, roughly 29,101 of the signatures submitted by the Committee were invalid for various reasons. Just five days prior, in a meeting in your office with Jared Hendrix (chairperson of the Committee), you indicated that your office had determined that roughly 7,000 signatures were invalid and would not be counted. An additional 22,000 signatures were “disqualified” in the five days between March 17 and March 22.

The North Dakota Constitution provides the Committee twenty days to correct or amend petitions for an initiative measure. N.D. Const. art. III, § 6. On March 22, the same day you made the decision not to certify the sufficiency of the Petitions, Mr. Hendrix requested all records from your office indicating your decision as to each signature and the complete legal basis for that decision. On March 24, you responded, telling Mr. Hendrix that copies of the petitions along with a tabulation summary—part, but not all, of what was requested—were being prepared, but were not yet ready. You stated that the Committee’s 20-day cure period would begin when the copies of the petitions were picked up from your office. A portion of the petitions were retrieved on March 28, 2022, the date you first made them available. During our review, it became apparent that 85 petitions were missing from the materials retrieved on March 28. We requested those missing petitions on April 6, 2022. On April 7, we received the vast majority of the petitions, and on April 11, we received the final three missing petitions.

Based on your representation to Mr. Hendrix, the Committee understands that its 20-day cure period ends on Sunday, April 17, 2022. To avoid any doubt about the legal effect of the period ending on Easter Sunday, we intend to supplement this letter on Friday, April 15, 2022.

For the reasons stated below, the Committee submitted a sufficient number of signatures to have the Term Limits issue placed on the ballot in November’s election.



**A. Over 8,000 signatures were unconstitutionally and unlawfully stricken on the mistaken basis that they were obtained before the approval date for circulation of the Petitions.**

Your office disqualified 8,274 signatures on the basis that they were obtained before the approval date. Pursuant to Article III, sect. 2 of the North Dakota Constitution, before an initiative petition may be circulated, the Secretary of State shall approve the petition for circulation. Initiative petitions may be circulated for one year from the date it is approved for circulation by the secretary of state. N.D.C.C. § 16.1-01-09(7).

The Committee's initiative petition was approved for signature gathering on July 16, 2021. See Ex. A. On April 4, 2022, Elections Specialist Lee Ann Oliver confirmed that this was the correct approval date "as a matter of public record" according to the timeline provided by the Secretary of State's website. Ex. C. Of the 224 petitions you disqualified as prematurely collected, only one packet (No. 1031) contained dates that were before the approval date.<sup>2</sup> None of the other 223 packets identified contain a signature dated before July 16, 2021. The packets appear to have been reviewed line by line by your office and include a number indicating the signatures your office would have been otherwise willing to accept, but for the approval date issue.<sup>3</sup>

Because the vast majority of the 8,274 signatures excluded on this basis were collected after the approval date and are otherwise valid, your office must accept the 7,015<sup>4</sup> signatures that were otherwise valid but for their erroneous exclusion based on the approval date issue. The sum of the signatures you originally accepted (17,265) and the signatures that should be counted from these erroneously excluded petition packets (7,015) yields a total of 24,280 valid signatures based on correcting this single error.

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<sup>2</sup> It appears the petition packet No. 1031 contained signatures with the date 6/25/2021. This only occurred on the first three signature lines and appears to be the signer's mistake. All other signatures were correctly dated 7/25/2021 or later. We have excluded the 3 invalid signatures from the 38 signatures the Secretary identified as otherwise acceptable within this petition packet.

<sup>4</sup> The 224 petitions that were erroneously disqualified for signatures being obtained before the approval date contained 7,018 otherwise acceptable signatures as identified by your office on the first page of the petition. We have subtracted the 3 potentially invalid signatures from packet No. 1031 to arrive at 7,015.



**B. Wholesale disqualification of signatures notarized by Zeph Toe for “likely forgery” based on an inexpert opinion regarding a few circulator signatures was unconstitutional and improper.**

Your office disqualified 751 petitions containing 15,740 signatures—about a third of the entire campaign—because you identified a few examples where you thought a circulator’s handwriting looked different than other handwriting from that same circulator. You claim that the signatures were notarized by the same notary: Zeph Toe. Because you deemed these differences in handwriting to indicate that one or the other of the signatures was “likely forged”, you in turn invalidated every single notarization of Zeph Toe, and therefore every single signature of otherwise-valid North Dakota electors. When the Committee requested that your office provide a record of the circulator affidavits that you believe were likely forged, you were unable to do so, pointing back to the few petition pages you revealed to the Committee during a live meeting just before you made your decision. Ex. C. This wholesale exclusion of these signatures is improper and hinders, rather than furthers, the right to petition under the North Dakota Constitution.

The North Dakota Constitution provides: “The petition shall be circulated only by electors. They shall swear thereon that the electors who have signed the petition did so in their presence.” Art. III, § 3. N.D.C.C. Section 16.1-01-09(3) provides that the circulators’ affidavits must be attached to each copy of the petition and requires the circulator to subscribe and swear before a notary public “that each signature contained on the attached petition was executed in my presence; and that to the best of my knowledge and belief each individual whose signature appears on the attached petition is a qualified elector; and that each signature contained on the attached petition is the genuine signature of the individual whose name it purports to be.”

If it is appropriate to exclude any signatures here on the basis of the “likely forgeries”, that exclusion should be limited to those petitions where the signature on the circulator’s affidavit actually suffers from some flaw. Though we understand that this may be difficult given that you were unable to identify precisely which signatures or affidavits were problematic, that does not justify the drastic leap taken here to throw out all signatures notarized by Zeph Toe.



Though it is our understanding that you did not speak to Mr. Toe at any time during your sufficiency determination, we conferred with Mr. Toe to expressly address the issues raised. Mr. Toe has provided an affidavit reaffirming that each circulator whose name appears on a petition did personally appear before him and execute the circulator's affidavit. Ex. D, at ¶ 8-11. Mr. Toe also reviewed the log that he keeps of each notarial act he performs. Ex. D, at ¶ 12-13. His log includes entries from the petitions signed by Chloe Lloyd and Ramona Morris, as well as copies of each of those circulators' signatures. From what we can discern from the information provided by your office, Ms. Lloyd and Ms. Morris are the circulators who your office believes may have had their signatures forged.<sup>5</sup>

Mr. Toe notarized thirty-six petitions circulated by Chloe Lloyd across nine occasions. Those petitions were notarized over a 19-day span from September 4, 2021 to September 23, 2021. *See* Ex. E. On their first encounter on September 4, 2021, Mr. Toe's log indicates that he checked Ms. Lloyd's identification. *Id.* Given the frequency with which Mr. Toe notarized Ms. Lloyd's petitions in the 19 days after that date, he did not check her identification each time and instead notarized Ms. Lloyd's petitions based on his personal recognition of her, as permitted under N.D. Stat. § 44-06.1-06. *Id.* Nonetheless, Mr. Toe checked Ms. Lloyd's identification again on September 21, 2021, and notarized petitions on each of the two following days. *Id.* Like the petitions themselves, many of the entries in Mr. Toe's log contain variations in the printed name and signatures provided by Ms. Lloyd. The most likely explanation for these variations is not forgery, but rather, that Ms. Lloyd's handwriting varies based on any number of circumstances that do not raise any inference of forgery or other wrongdoing. As he attests and his logbook shows, Mr. Toe verified Ms. Lloyd's identity each time she signed her circulator's affidavit and has no reason to believe that any other person signed in Ms. Lloyd's name. Ex. D, ¶ 14-19.

Similarly, Mr. Toe notarized six petitions circulated by Ramona Morris across four occasions. These petitions were notarized between November 8 and November 15, 2021. *See* Ex. F. Mr. Toe checked Ms. Morris's identification on November 8 and November 11,

according to his logbook. *Id.* Like the petitions themselves, many of the entries in Mr. Toe's log contain variations in the printed name and signatures provided by Ms. Morris. Like Ms. Lloyd, the most likely explanation for these variations is not forgery. As he attests and his logbook shows, Mr. Toe verified Ms. Morris's identity each time she signed her circulator's affidavit and has no reason to believe that any other person signed in Ms. Morris's name. Ex. D, at ¶ 14-19.

Your office's brief, inexpert analysis of Ms. Lloyd's and Ms. Morris's handwriting is no basis to exclude all of the signatures they gathered—let alone all of the North Dakota elector signatures on petitions notarized by Mr. Toe. Based on the affidavit of Mr. Toe and his notary log, your office must correct your error. The 751 petitions containing 15,740 signatures cannot be rejected merely because they were notarized by Mr. Toe, as there is no factual or legal basis for the assertion that he permitted or acquiesced to forgery in the process.

Adding this sum into the total reflecting the correction of the approval date issue, your office should accept at least 40,020 of the signatures submitted before rectifying any additional issues involving elector signatures that were erroneously excluded for reasons relating to the elector's name, signature, address, etc.

## CONCLUSION

This initiative should be submitted to the people of North Dakota. Solely by correcting the two most glaring issues with your office's exclusion of signatures – the approval date issue and the Zeph Toe issue – the Committee has submitted at least 40,020 valid signatures, or 8,856 more than required by law. We expect this surplus to grow as we continue to review the signatures you chose to exclude on other bases.

As will be seen in our next submission, thousands of otherwise-valid signatures of North Dakota electors were excluded for trifling and unlawful reasons, such as an identifiable printed name that was not printed neatly enough because the voter did not lift his or her pen between each printed letter, or because the voter omitted a directional (like "S." in "S. Main St.") from an address.

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We know that your team was instructed not to follow the statutory sampling process (in which the post office would certainly have delivered postcards to term limits-supporting voters). Instead, it reviewed every single signature against the VOICES database using these new criteria that were crafted exclusively for the term limits petition. Therefore, you and your staff were well aware that valid signatures which matched voter records were being stricken based on minor technicalities, and sometimes based on no valid reason at all, such as the 7,000 signatures dated after July 16, but stricken based on the theory they were signed before that date. No expense was spared in attempting to disqualify this petition, and the full scope of the use of taxpayer resources to frustrate the will of the electors is only beginning to come into focus. The state's validation process here should be subject to a full inquiry. We ask that your office and the Attorney General continue to preserve all records—paper and electronic—regarding the effort to review the petition and strike signatures, which were the subject of our earlier document preservation request.

We will supplement our position this Friday in accordance with your representation regarding the Committee's cure period starting on March 28, 2022. We implore you to reconsider your position in accordance with the information provided above. The Committee reserves and does not waive any and all rights and remedies against you or any other party relating to the Petitions.

Dear Mr. Hendrix,

On February 15, 2022, I accepted delivery of 1,441 petitions related to setting term limits for the Governor and Legislators and that any future amendments to these term limit provisions may only be proposed by a citizen-initiated petition and never by the Legislature. The petitions contained 46,315 signatures. For an initiative petition to be placed on a ballot, it must be signed by electors equal in number to four percent of the population of the State of North Dakota, which in this case is 31,164 signatures.

According to state law, N.D.C.C. § 16.1-01-10, the Secretary of State has a reasonable period, not to exceed thirty-five days, to pass upon the sufficiency of the petitions. Based on a review of the petitions by my office and an investigation by the Attorney General's Bureau of Criminal Investigation, the petitions do not have a sufficient number of valid signatures. Excluding the invalid signatures, the petitions only contain 17,265 valid signatures. Therefore, I will not certify it for placement on the November ballot.

According to the North Dakota Constitution, Article III, Section 3, petitions may only be circulated by electors and each elector must swear that the signatures were affixed in their presence. The reasons for which individual signatures and entire petitions have been excluded include:

- Several signatures of circulators were likely forged on affidavits in the presence of a notary public. Therefore, all affidavits (attached to 751 petitions that included 15,740 signatures) notarized by this notary were not counted.
- Some circulators were not North Dakota qualified electors as required, and some of those individuals were not citizens of the United States.
- A sampling of the 87 circulators indicated that several were offered, or paid bonuses based on the number of signatures they obtained, which is prohibited by N.D.C.C. 16.1-01-12(1)(j). Any signature obtained in violation of this statute is void and may not be counted.
- Petitions included a significant number of signatures from residents of other states in violation of N.D.C.C. § 16.1-01-09(2).
- On the petition, signers are required by law to print their name, affix their signature, and provide a complete address, as witnessed by the circulator. Thousands of the signatures did not meet all aspects of this requirement (e.g., incomplete addresses).

Additionally, as required by N.D.C.C. § 16.1-01-10, I must report all violations to the Attorney General.

Do you also have the csv/excel list of the numbers for packets notarized by Zeph Toe? **I have attached the list you requested.**

In the documents we picked up, I was looking to find some clarification on the notary issue. The summary letter said this:

Several signatures of circulators were likely forged on affidavits in the presence of a notary public. Therefore, all affidavits (attached to 751 petitions that included 15,740 signatures) notarized by this notary were not counted. But I don't find any details on which affidavits are considered forgeries. **Can you please send a list of those?** The list you have requested does not exist. However, Zeph Toe notarized several petitions despite the fact that the signatures of the same circulator were different on a number of the petitions supposedly circulated by the same person.

Also, from the summary letter,  
*Some circulators were not North Dakota qualified electors as required, and some of those individuals were not citizens of the United States.*

**Can I get a list of the petitions rejected for this?** That information was provided to Mr. Hendrix on a PDF containing the details found on every petition when the copies of the petitions were provided. I have attached the PDF already provided to Mr. Hendrix.

*A sampling of the 87 circulators indicated that several were offered, or paid bonuses based on the number of signatures they obtained, which is prohibited by N.D.C.C. 16.1-01- 12(1) U). Any signature obtained in violation of this statute is void and may not be counted. Petitions included a significant number of signatures from residents of other states in violation of N.D.C.C. § 16.1-01-09(2).*

# EXHIBIT D

## AFFIDAVIT OF ZEPH TOE

Before me, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared Zeph Toe, who is personally known to me (or, if not being personally known to me, did confirm his/her identity presenting Drives License as identification), and appearing to be fully competent and of sufficient age, upon being duly sworn, stated upon his oath the following:

1. My name is Zeph Toe.
2. I am over the age of 18 and a resident of North Dakota.
3. I am a duly commissioned notary in North Dakota, commissioned by the North Dakota Secretary of State to perform notarial acts.
4. I have been a notary in North Dakota since June 29, 2021 and have been in good standing from that day to present.
5. My current commission expires on June 29, 2025.
6. In 2021 and 2022, I notarized the signatures of several petition circulators who collected signatures on behalf of the North Dakota for Term Limits committee.
7. At all times relevant hereto, I was duly commissioned and in good standing to perform notarial acts in the state of North Dakota.
8. Each time a petition circulator appeared before me, I required them to identify themselves in accordance with N.D. Stat. § 44-06.1-06.
9. If I was unable to substantiate the identification of the petition circulator, I refused to notarize their petition packet.
10. Once the necessary information was filled out, I then witnessed each petition circulator sign the respective packet.

11. The circulator would then hand me the packet, after which I filled out the notarial certificate and notarized the document, affixing my notary stamp device and signature to the packet.
12. I have had the opportunity to review the log I keep as a record of the notarial acts I performed.
13. Based on my review of that log, I did not identify any issues, reservations, concerns, or suspicions of forgery on any of the petitions I notarized.
14. I am not aware of any person signing in the name of another on any of the packets that I notarized.
15. If I was aware that someone was attempting to forge a signature, I would not have permitted the forgery to occur, nor would I have notarized a forged signature.
16. I would not allow someone to add, change, or delete information from the signature page within the packet after I notarized the document.
17. I am not aware of anyone adding to, changing, or deleting information on a signature page after I notarized the document.
18. Because the person appearing before me to sign the packet was identified in accordance with N.D. Stat. § 44-06.1-06 prior to signing the packet, I did not compare each signature witnessed to prior or other signatures of the same circulator.
