



Survey Summary

The results of the survey taken of 1,299 registered voters in Alaska indicate that 88 percent of the voters in Alaska favor a constitutional amendment that would place term limits on members of Congress. In addition, a majority (90%) of the voters would want their state senator or representative to vote yes if an amendment for term limits on Congress was proposed.
