

CALIFORNIA CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT 30 TERM LIMITS POLL: EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

US Term Limits survey Conducted September 8-11, 2023 by RMG Research Group. 400 likely primary voters of CA-30 participated in the survey.

A majority (82%) of the voters favor an amendment to the U.S. Constitution that will place term limits on U.S. Senators and U.S. House Representatives. Voters also say that they would be more likely to vote for someone who signed the U.S. Term Limits pledge and that they are more likely to support state lawmakers who help advance congressional term limits.

Methodology

The survey of 400 Likely Primary Voters was conducted for USTL on September 8-11, 2023. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by gender, age, and race. Likely voters were determined by a screening process within the survey.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 4.5 percentage points.

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
