US Term Limits Survey of 500 Likely Democratic Primary Voters In MD Conducted November 15-17, 2023

1. Do you approve or disapprove of the way President Biden is performing his job?

- 34% Strongly approve
- 46% Somewhat approve
- 13% Somewhat disapprove
- 6% Strongly disapprove
- 1% Not sure

2* Several candidates are running to be the Democratic nominee for Senate. If the primary election were held today, for whom would you vote?

- 45% David Trone
- 25% Angela Alsobrooks
- 4% Someone else
- 1% Would not vote
- 25% Not sure

3* Do you favor or oppose term limits for members of Congress?

- 48% Strongly favor
- 34% Somewhat favor
- 8% Somewhat oppose
- 3% Strongly oppose
- 7% Not sure





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4* [Asked of those who favor Term Limits] How many 2-year terms should a member of Congress be allowed to serve?

6% 1 term 38% 2 terms 18% 3 terms 20% 4 terms 7% 5 terms 3% 6 terms 2% 7 terms 1% 8 terms 3% 10 terms 0% 12 terms

5* Suppose you knew that David Trone signed the U.S. Term Limits Pledge and supports term limits, but the other candidates oppose term limits. If you knew that to be true and the election were held today, for whom would you vote?

- 59% David Trone
- 17% Angela Alsobrooks
- 3% Someone else
- 1% Would not vote
- 20% Not sure

Methodology

The survey of 500 Likely Democratic Primary Voters was conducted online for USTL on November 15-17, 2023. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by gender, age, and race. Likely voters were determined by a screening process within the survey.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 4.4 percentage points.
